Her Berber and Tuareg origins provide Hindi Zahra with an exceptional and beautiful melodic range, both in Arabic, French and English languages. Her music and compositions also shine with North African influences in a very acoustic and dry sound, punctuated by percussions and hand clapping. Her music has been called 'an ancestral blues, original jazz and oriental vibration'. Hindi was born in Morocco in a family of Berber artists, including renowned Amazigh band Oudaden, and was initiated to traditional Gnaoua music, as well as she discovered Bob Dylan, Bob Marley's reggae, then Ali Farka Touré's Malian blues and Ismaël Lo's sensual folk music. With her very moving voice, with Billie Holiday accents, Hindi Zahra's music is singular and different from anything else you will hear in the Midem Talent selection.
